Hello everyone, this kind of painting I drew belongs to a kind of Chinese painting. It's a new year's animal playing ball. It's also called Nian Mo, Xi, Nian, Sui. It's the evil animal in the ancient Chinese folklore, which is related to the new year's Eve and the Spring Festival. It is said that the new year beast is big and small, tens of feet long, with eyes like bronze bells, and comes and goes like wind. When it cries, it makes a sound of "Nian ~", so it's called the new year beast. For a long time, people gradually found that the beast was afraid of three things, namely, red, fire and loud noise; so later people would gather together when the beast was about to arrive on New Year's Eve, paste red paper (later gradually changed to paste peaches or red couplets), hang red lanterns, set off firecrackers and so on, in order to drive the beast away. When the beast was driven away, people would always happily say to each other, "another year has passed." Gradually there is a new year's aying, and thus the custom of the new year o on the other side of the painting, I want to draw the characters or animals or things that are representative of American festival characteristics. For example, Halloween, Christmas, Thanksgiving and so on. You can also add some other ideas in it. Let's finish this perfect work together!
